

- Created to be annually given to young scientists or researchers based in the Asia-Pacific region, who have made significant contributions in the field of sustainable development
- For 2008-2009, awards will be given in each of the three areas:
  - Business
  - Engineering and Technology
  - Agriculture and Natural Sciences
- Candidates should be employed by HEIs in the Asia-Pacific region
- Applications will be evaluated by an international panel of three recognised experts in sustainable development from the relevant areas
