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## Environmental Policy Integration/ 環境政策統合

- Weak EPI/ 弱い統合
  - “Non” environmental sectors consider the overall environmental consequences of their policies, while the core of sectoral policies remains essentially untouched
- Strong EPI/ 強い統合
  - Placing environmental considerations at the heart of decision making in other sectoral policies
  - Give priority to the environment over sectoral policies before any trade-off are made between environmental, economic and social objectives

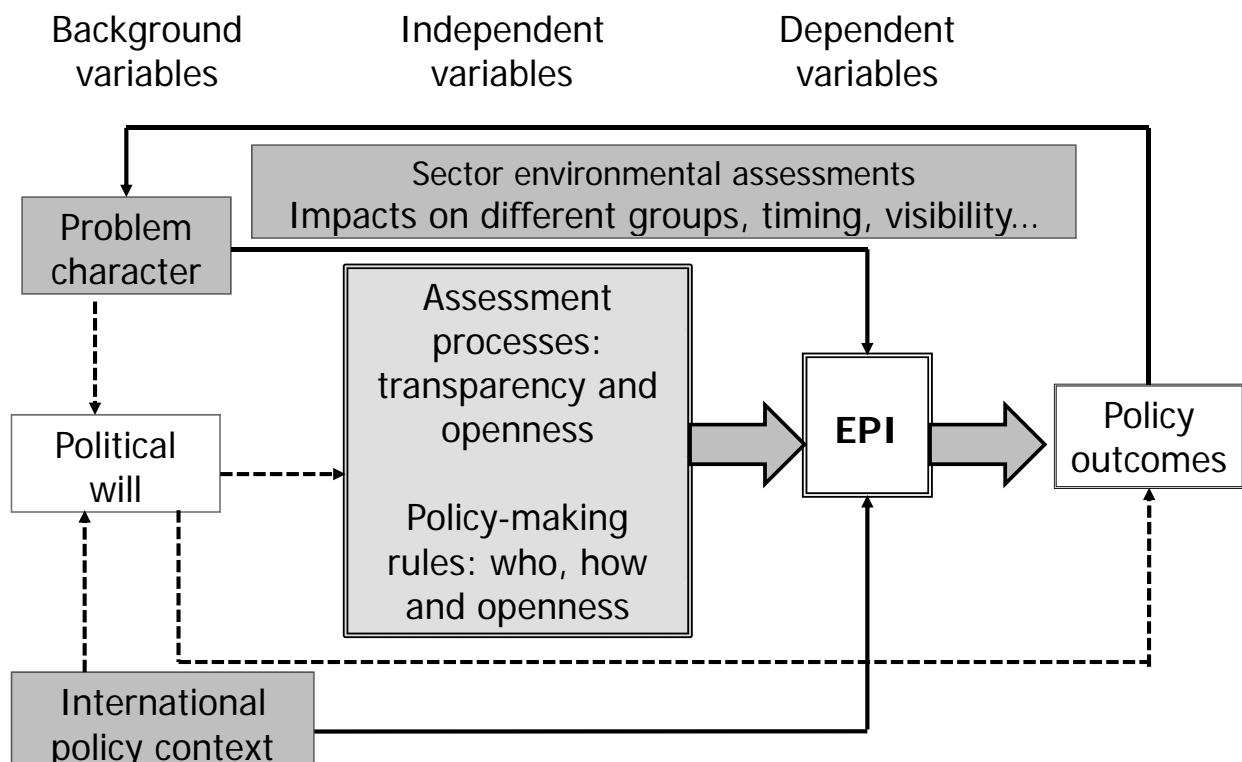
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# Expected Impacts of EPI/ EPI進展から期待される成果

- More rational, less ad hoc way of policy decisions
- Offers opportunity for environmental policy to work with sectoral policies to the mutual benefit of the environment and economy
- Help to **reorient** policies, preventing environmental damages and putting sectors on the path to long-term sustainability
- Greater effectiveness in achieving environmental goals by **ensuring coherence** across different policy areas
- Strengthen transparency and public participation
