

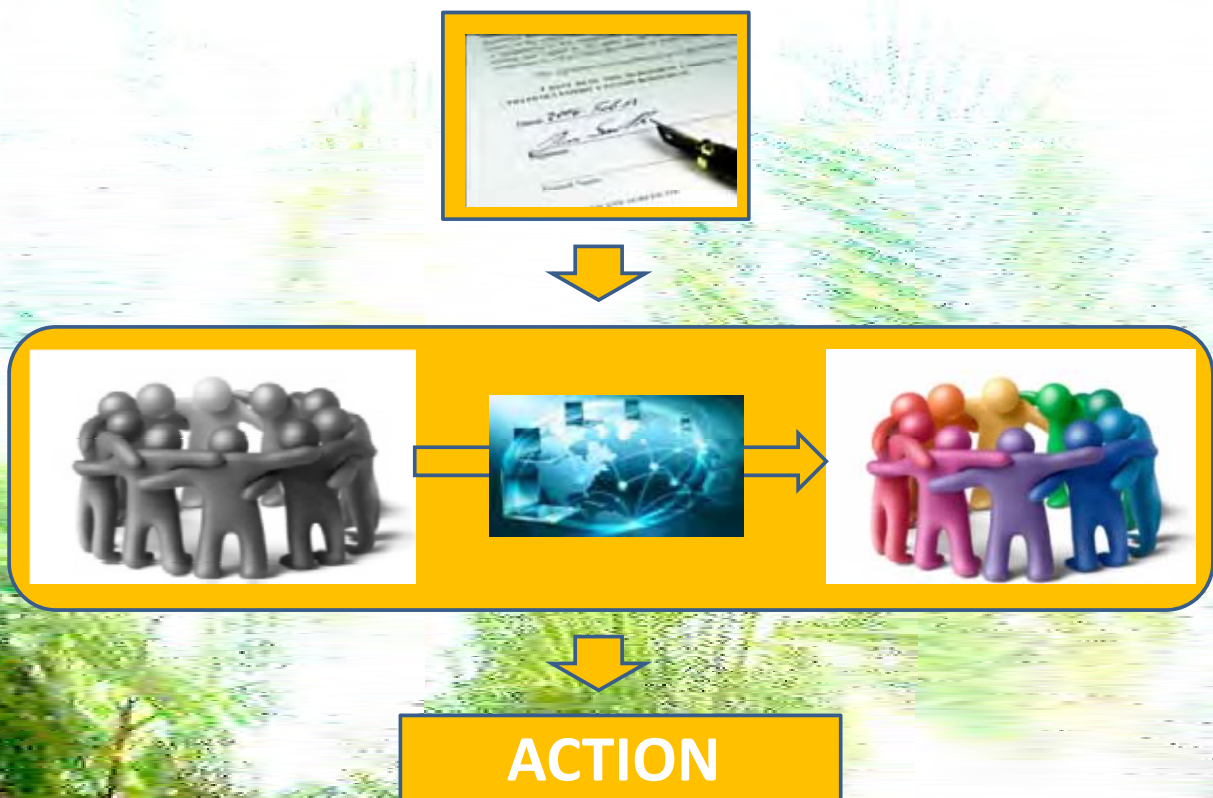

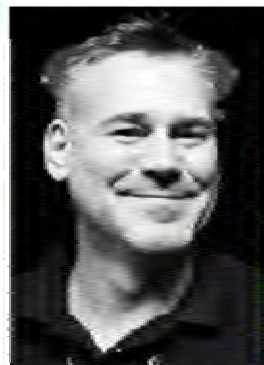
Key Questions 主要課題

Discussion Point 1: What are the key elements for successful knowledge sharing? What kind of knowledge should an organization/initiative manage? Any lessons from existing cases?

Discussion Point 2: What are the critical elements for formulating and operating an effective CoP that facilitates knowledge sharing and management (mechanisms, incentives, etc.)? Can a CoP improve the sustainability of a network beyond its externally funded period?

Discussion Point 3: What kind contribution can IT make to a CoP in improving knowledge sharing and management? Can IT technologies provide a dynamic environment where practitioners can interact (as opposed to static provision of information through websites)?
