**Why invest in DRR in education?**

- Investing 1, saves 2  
Every dollar invested in disaster risk reduction saves two dollars in reconstruction.
- Half a million deaths and 40 million injuries  
An estimated 100 million people are vulnerable to natural hazards. Every year, 200,000 people are killed and 100 million injured by natural hazards. 40 million people are displaced and 100 million are left homeless.
- 15 million children affected  
An estimated 15 million children are affected by natural hazards every year. 10 million of them are in school.
- safeguarding development  
Disaster risk reduction is essential for safeguarding development. It is a key component of disaster risk management and is essential for achieving the Millennium Development Goals.
