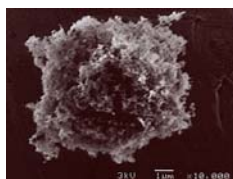

**Methane**



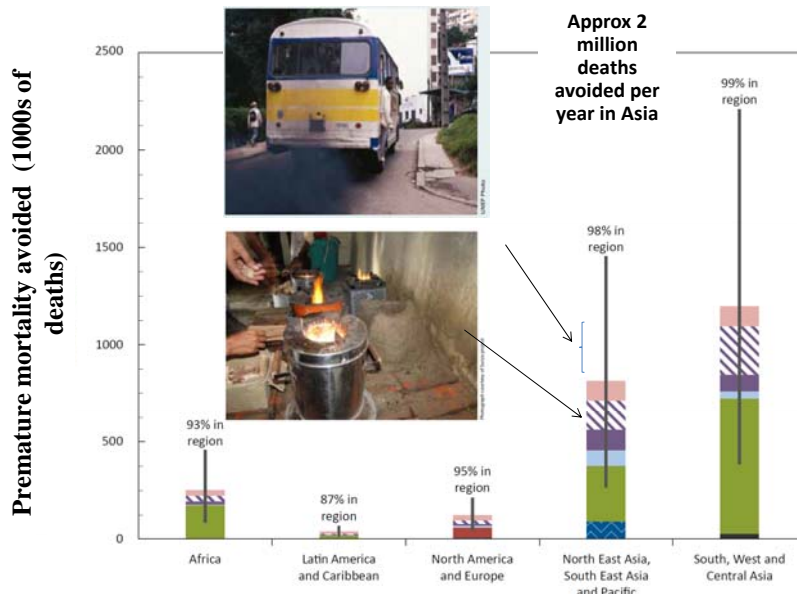
**Tropospheric Ozone**



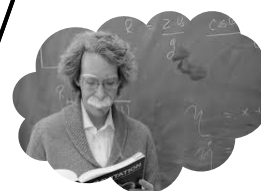
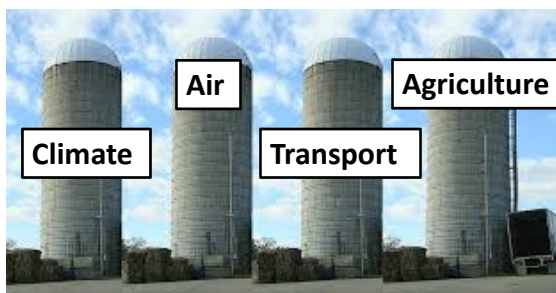
Substance	Lifetime
Carbon dioxide	Decades to centuries; about 20% will exist for millennia
Ozone	4-18 days
Methane	12 years
Black carbon	3-8 days
