



## Technology Transfer – Supply Chain




#### Facilitation of technology transfer

- 1. Modes of technology transfer are diverse.
  - Necessary to support them differently (next slide)
- Support for <u>match making</u> between technology providers and receivers by aid agencies, UN organizations, NGOs etc.. is helpful as an initial step. To make it replicable and scalable, creation of <u>enabling environments</u> is a key. For example,
  - Match making: demonstration project/program of energyefficient equipment by partnership of aid agency, technology providers and technology users
  - Enabling environments: energy efficiency standards and concessional loan programs for technology adoption
- 3. Technology transfer to SMEs: In terms of scaling and replicability, focusing on common areas among SMEs may be a good strategy.
  - e.g. efficient generation and use of heat
