



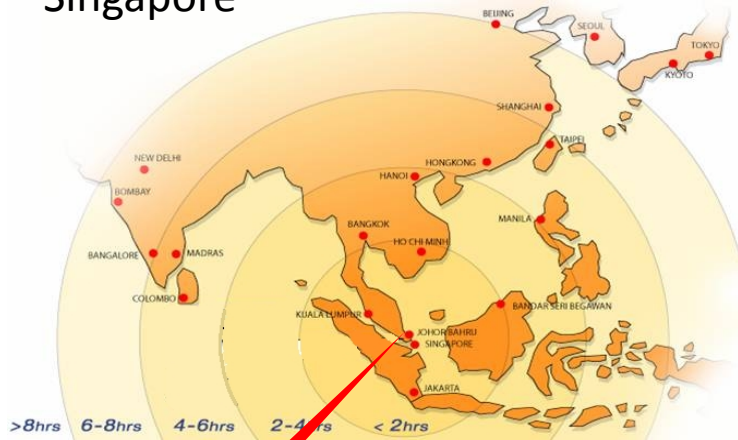

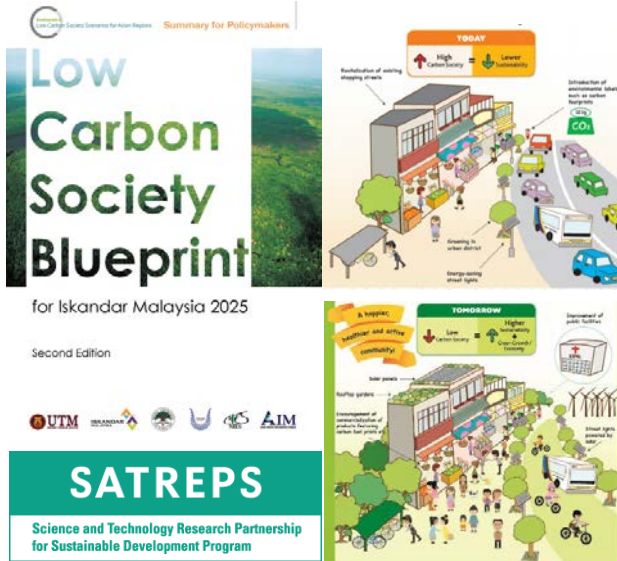

Handing over the LCS Action Plan by the Chief Minister Johor to 5 Local Authorities in Iskandar Malaysia



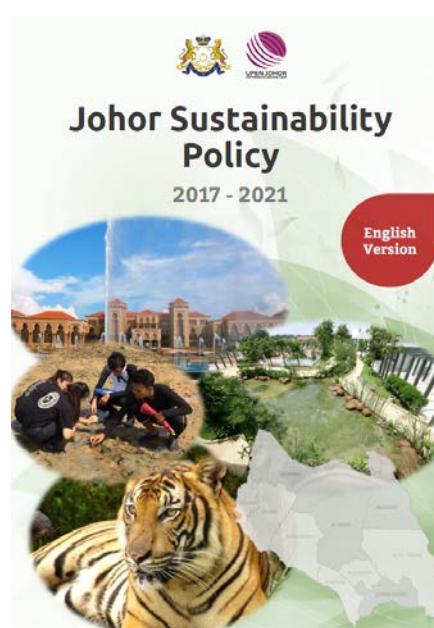
