

VISION


- To be a platform for Thailand concerning information of climate change risks and adaptation.

 - 6) Natural Resource Management





- June 16, 2019, during <u>G20 Ministerial</u>
 Meeting on Energy Transitions and Global
 Environment for Sustainable Growth, Nagano,
 Japan
- Ministry of the Environment, Japan (MOEJ) officially launched the Asia-Pacific Climate Change Adaptation Information Platform (AP-PLAT) and held the AP-PLAT Launching Ceremony.
- AP-PLAT was also submitted as one of the actions in the G20 Action Agenda on Adaptation and Resilient Infrastructure, which was concluded as an outcome of the G20 Ministerial Meeting.
