The Japanese Government established **the SDGs Promotion Headquarters** in May 2016, headed by the Prime Minister, to ensure **a whole-of-government approach** to implement the 2030 Agenda in a comprehensive and effective manner and formulated the SDGs Implementation Guiding Principles as a mid-to-long term national strategy for achieving the SDGs in Japan and internationally by 2030.
