Basics of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

- Tool to tackle global challenges to realize a sustainable world
- Adopted in 2015, to be achieved by 2030
- Part of "the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development (the 2030 Agenda)"
- Covers economic, social and environmental dimensions
 - → requires an **integrated approach**
- Consists of 17 Goals and 169 targets
- 247 indicators to assess progress on targets
- Not legally binding
- Not only countries but all stakeholders are encouraged to work towards the SDGs
- → requires **stakeholder engagement**




