




# The latest assessment of the SDGs targets paints

#### a concerning picture:


- About half of the targets are moderately or severely off track
- Over one-third have either seen no movement or regressed below the 2015 baseline







Progress assessment for the 17 Goals based on assessed targets, 2023 or latest data (percentage)








#### The world could face big misses across the Goals by 2030


If current trends continue, by 2030:

Prioritizing policies and investments that have multiplier effects across the goals




Securing a surge in Sustainable Development Goals financing and an enabling global environment for developing countries

COUNTRIES WITH >60% FUNDING GAP IN THEIR STATISTICAL PROGRAMME










