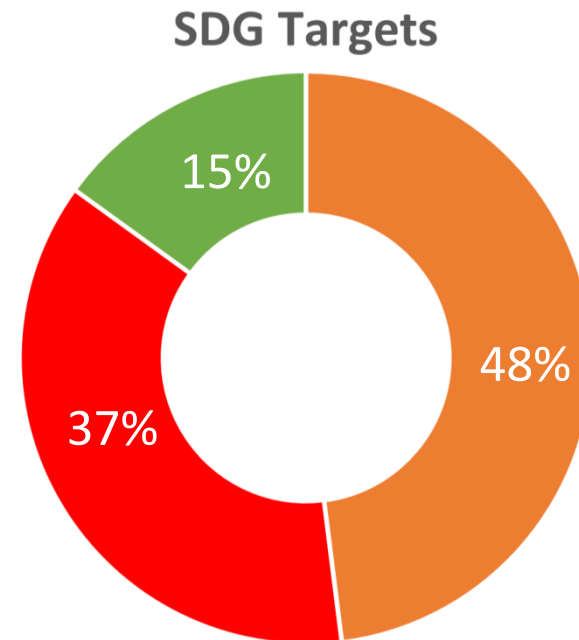

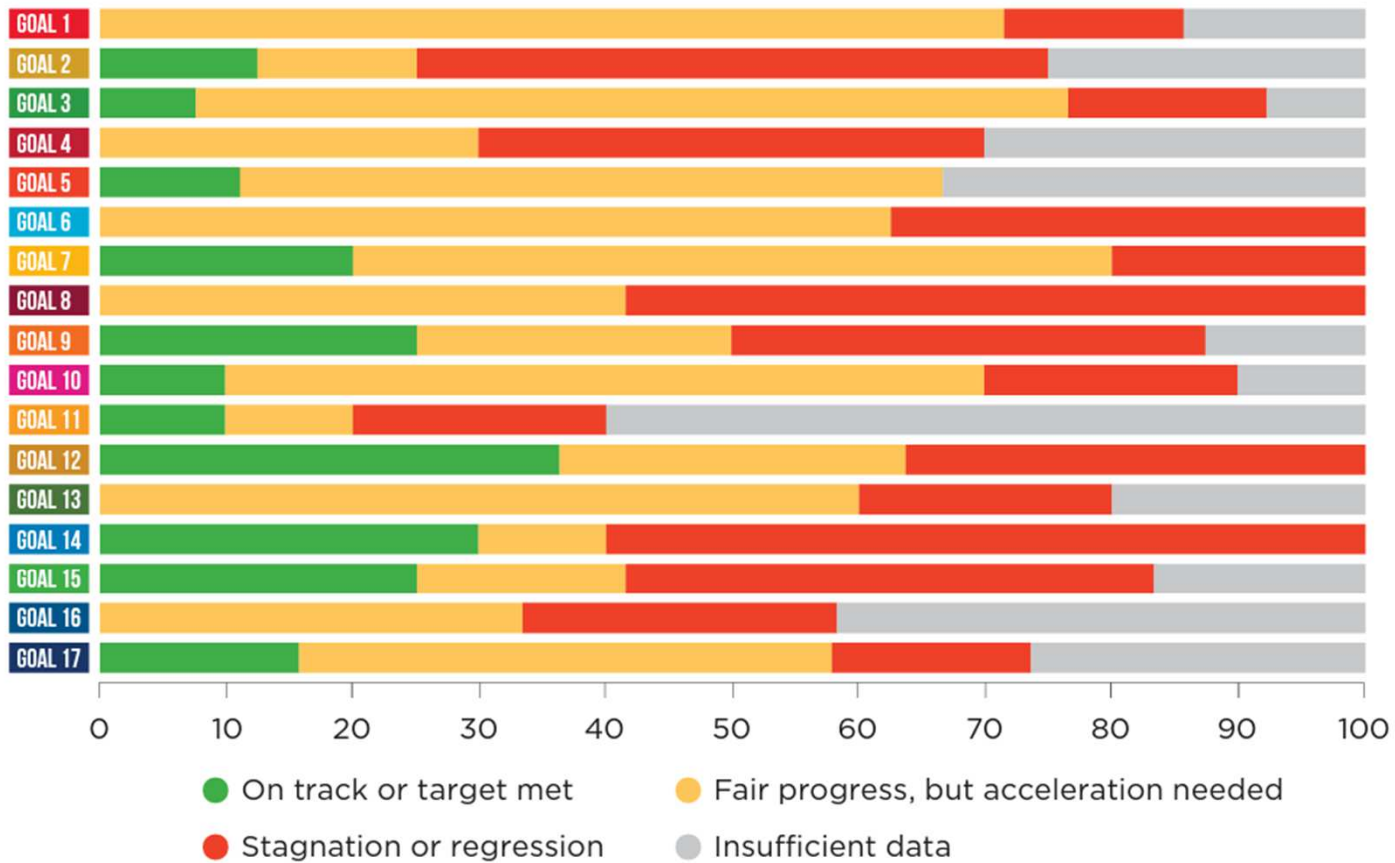


The latest assessment of the SDGs targets paints a concerning picture:

- About **half of the targets** are moderately or severely **off track**
- Over **one-third** have either seen **no movement or regressed** below the 2015 baseline



Progress assessment for the 17 Goals based on assessed targets, 2023 or latest data (percentage)



The world could face **big misses** across the Goals by 2030

If current trends continue, **by 2030**:

Equipping governance and institutions for sustainable and inclusive transformation



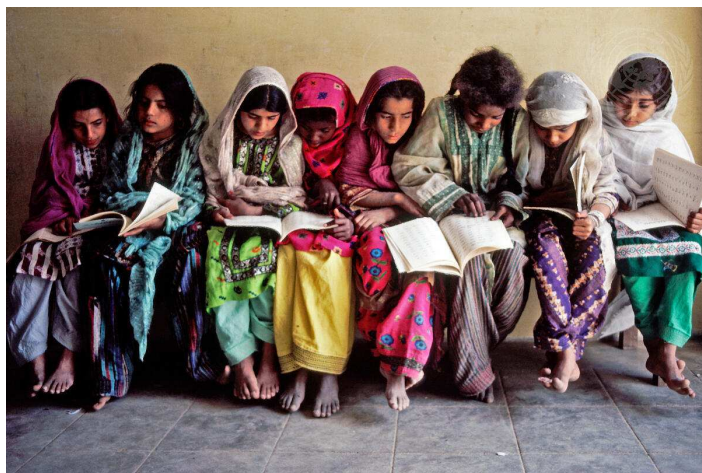
Prioritizing policies and investments that have multiplier effects across the goals

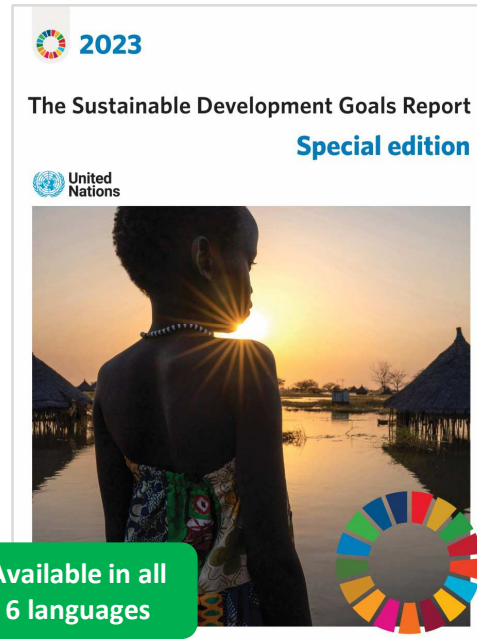

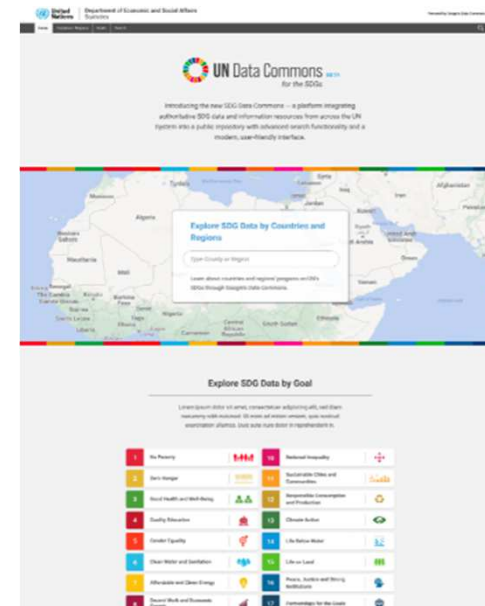
