The A6IP is an international initiative to enable the effective implementation of Article 6 ("A6") of the Paris Agreement. Launched at COP27 by the Ministry of the Environment, Japan, our ultimate goal is to **build high integrity carbon markets — one consistent with ambitious, science-aligned emissions pathways, to achieve net-zero emissions by 2050. The Center was endorsed by G7 countries to uphold the principles of High-integrity Carbon Markets.**

With **70+ countries and dozens of public/private organizations already on board**, our Partnership draws upon the strengths and experiences of partners from every continent to advance A6 implementation.

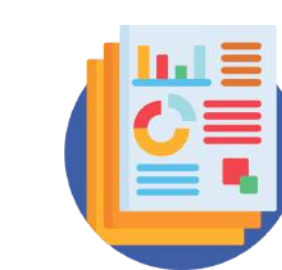
Article 6 Strategy:

Preparation for Initial Report, Annual Report, and the Report on Regular Information



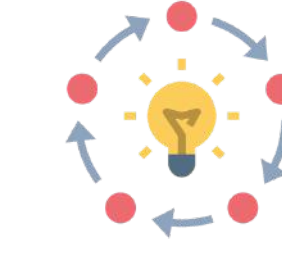
