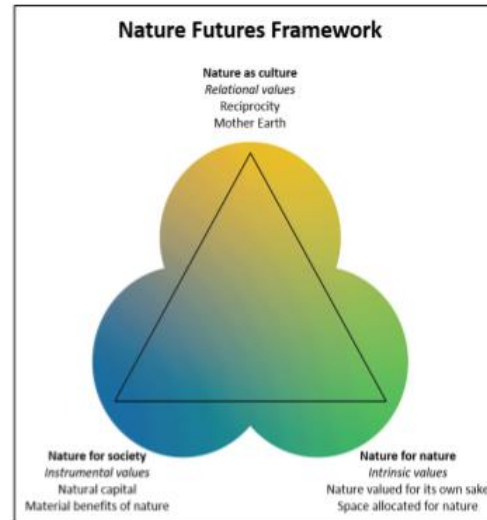
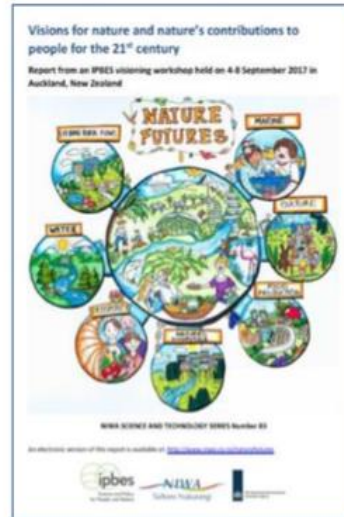
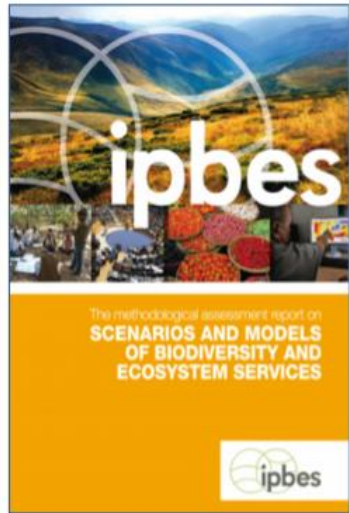

TSU-SCM (IGES)

Phase I (2014-2016):
Assessment of the use of scenarios and models of BES

Phase II (2016-2019):
initial development of the Nature Futures Framework

Phase III (2019-2023):
further development of Nature Futures Framework scenarios

IPBES-10 (2023): NFF Methodological Guidance

1. IPBES Methodological Assessment of Scenarios and Models of Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (2014-2016)
2. IPBES expert group on scenarios and models (2016-2019)
3. IPBES task force on scenarios and models (2019 - 2023)

Key responsibilities of TSU

• A. Provision of support on scenarios and models for IPBES assessments

- **Peer review** of the existing and new IPBES assessments
- **Mobilizing experts** on scenarios and models
- **Providing advice and input** to IPBES assessment author groups
- **Organizing an in-person workshop** to better account for different knowledge systems especially ILK (the second quarter of 2025)

C. Developing and monitoring a set of relevant indicators for measuring effectiveness

• B. Promoting dialogue between IPBES and the communities of practice

- **Mobilizing** existing communities
- Provision of **guidance** and information
- Collection of **examples** on NFF
- **Engagement with the climate** and other scenarios and models communities
- **Foster coherence** and facilitate the exchange of ideas
- **Engaging with various stakeholders** to disseminate, discuss, and further develop
- Providing an **update to NFF methodological guidance** for IPBES-12
